The group, based in St. Louis, MO, has been steadily making a name for themselves over the past two years. Whether singing at major festivals or at more intimate gatherings, their ability to connect with their audiences immediately and in a meaningful way is notable. The rapport of the group brings humor to their shows, and their musical storytelling combined with the fine blend of their voices makes their singing memorable. The quartet has recently released their debut album.
